Since its first publication in 1925, *The Great Gatsby* has been reissued numerous times in the US and other countries with a lot of different covers. Below you see a selection of these.

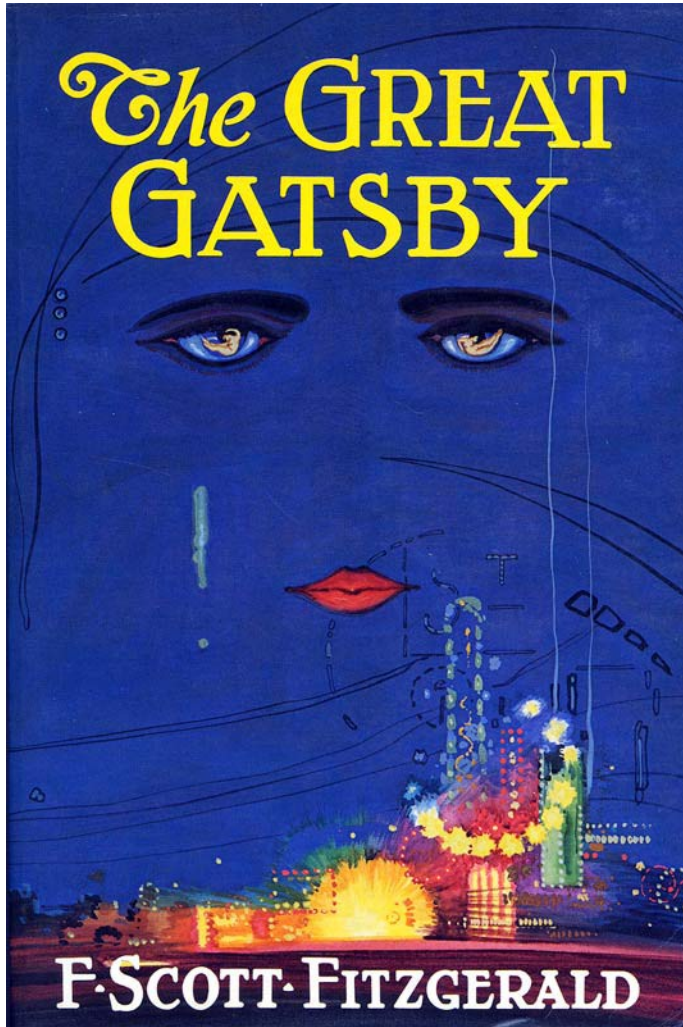

In each group there are 4 students. Three of you will have a cover which you will argue is the best cover for *The Great Gatsby*. The fourth student will be the judge who decides who made the best argument and consequently which cover wins.

All the winners from the groups will argue in front of the class who vote for their favorite argument and thereby the best cover of them all.

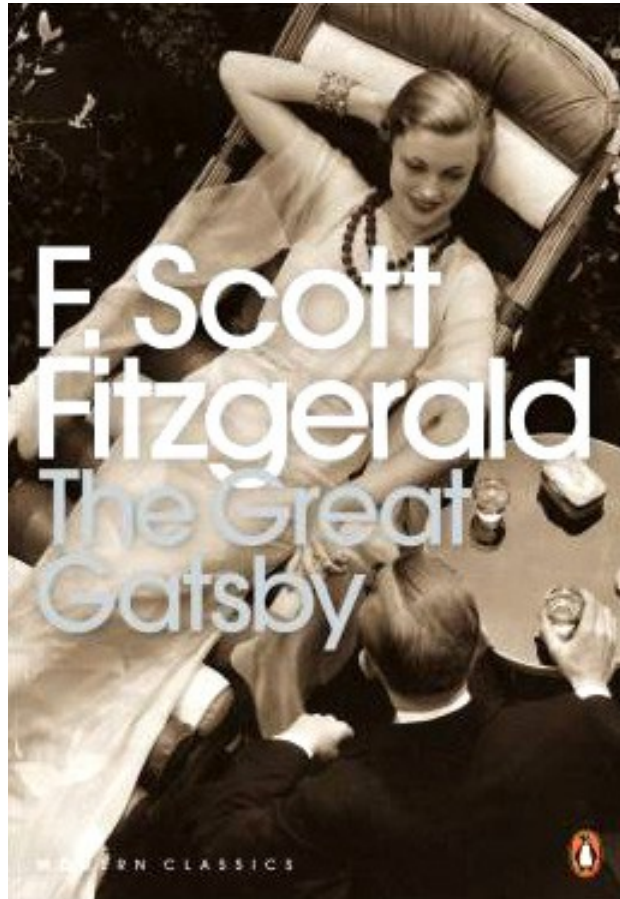
